# Four-Year Study of the Impact of the ZAPS ACT Test-Preparation Class on ACT Composite Performance, Melissa Whitman

#### Study Questions

- 1) Does the ZAPS ACT Test-Preparation Class have a significant impact on the ACT Composite Score?
- 2) Is the ZAPS class more effective if students are allowed a longer period of study and practice before taking the ACT?

### Summary of the Study

Juniors who had never taken the ACT were encouraged to sign up for the October or December test date. This provided baseline scores for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the ZAPS ACT Test-Preparation Class, which were scheduled in late February or early March. Following the ZAPS class, students again took the ACT in April or June. Over a period of four years, there were 94 students who took both of the ACT tests and also participated in a ZAPS class. This is about 15% of the total number of students who took the ACT during this period. Five of these students were eliminated from the study because they had taken the test multiple times prior or had participated in extensive outside test preparation courses.

**Conclusion on Question 1:** As shown on Table 1, the 89 students in the study scored an average ACT Composite of 19.78 on the initial test. This score was slightly below the district average of 20.1. On the second test, these students scored an average ACT Composite of 21.59, an <u>average increase of 1.81</u>. Depending on a student's percentile rank, this increase translates to <u>11-14 percentile points improvement</u>. This change is significant, both statistically and practically.

**Conclusion on Question 2:** On the 89 students in the study, 67 of them took the post test in April, 4-5 weeks after completing the ZAPS class. The other 22 students took the post test in June, about 12-13 weeks after completing the class. As shown on Table 2, the change in the April scores averaged 1.81. As shown on Table 3, the change in the June scores averaged 1.82. There is no indication that the additional study time makes any difference in the post test score.

## Limitations of the Data

The data suggests that the ZAPS Seminar had the greatest impact with students who initially scored between 18 and 24, although our sample size at each score point was not large enough to draw any firm conclusions.

In general, students who scored 30 or higher on the first test chose not to take the ZAPS class or retake the ACT. With only one student in the data set, we cannot make any statements about effectiveness of ZAPS with the top 1%.

No record was kept of the amount of time each student studied the materials after attending the ZAPS class, so it is not possible to correlate study time with performance.

#### Questions for Further Study

What is the impact of the ZAPS class on students within each quartile? What is the impact by subject area?

What is the relationship between study time and performance on the post test? Would there be a greater benefit if the study time were guided by a teacher or tutor?
